

**Kinder World
Preschool and Child Care**

Income Information / Recovery of Fraud Claims

The California Department of Education requires Kinder World Preschool and Child Care to inform all families receiving subsidized funds from Programs, that if your child care funds are obtained by providing fraudulent information or incomplete information, Kinder World Preschool and Child Care shall actively pursue recovering the funds paid out for the child care services.

Any fraudulent, false or misleading information provided to Kinder World Preschool and Child Care regarding your employment, income, status as a student, or being enrolled in a training program or your eligibility relating to medical incapacitation will be grounds for termination and will be cause for Kinder World Preschool and Child Care to recover funds.

In addition, I understand that failure to provide information regarding my eligibility and/or providing false, fraudulent or misleading information will not only result in termination from the Child Action, Inc. subsidized program, but will also result in my having to pay back any money paid out for my child(ren)'s care.

FAILURE TO: report information regarding wages (including commission checks, overtime checks, and bonuses), and other income received such as child support, which is needed to document eligibility and parent fees...

Report loss of employment within 10 calendar days of your last day of employment...

Report change in employment due to temporary lay-off and/or medical leave...

Report changes in family size (including marriage, separation, divorce, addition or loss of dependents)...

Report that you dropped classes or stopped attending a training program after you enrolled...

Provide complete and true documentation for any other reported adults in the household...

Will result in termination from the program and will be cause for recovery of funds.

Kinder World Preschool and Child Care will attempt to recover funds by developing a repayment plan with the parent. If the parent does not respond to the repayment plan or continually misses payments as outlined in the plan, a claim may be filed with Small Claims Court or the account may be turned over to a collection service for processing. The claim may also be referred to the District Attorney's Office.

Any family terminated for any of the above reasons is entitled to a fair hearing. If they lose their appeal, they will also be required to pay for childcare services provided during the time the appeal was being heard.

I have read the above information and understand that failure to provide information regarding either my eligibility and/or providing false, fraudulent or misleading information will not only result in my termination from Kinder World Preschool and Child Care subsidized program, but will also result in my having to pay back money for child care to Kinder World/Treehouse Learning Center

Under penalty of perjury, I declare the above statement to be true and factual.
